Registration & Payment Dates: Registration opens on October 4, 2019. Deadline to pay and register is Nov 13, 2019, 11:59 PM IST

Register for regular (May 4-15, 2020) and late testing (May 20-22, 2020) exams before the deadline.

*After the November 13, 2019 registration deadline, students may register for both the Regular and Late Testing cycle between November 16, 2019 and March 10, 2020. However, these registrations will qualify as 'late order' and attract a late order fee to be paid to College Board. Please check the AP exam fee section to know the price of tests registered for between November 16, 2019 and March 10, 2020. **USIEF New Delhi will not accept registrations on November 14, 2019 and November 15, 2019.***

AP Exam Fee:

Regular Testing Exam: Rs. **13,500** per AP Exam (For registration by Nov 13, 2019)

Late Testing Exam: Rs. **16,500** per AP Exam (For registration by Nov 13, 2019)

Regular Testing Exam: Rs. **17,500** per AP Exam (For registration from Nov 16, 2019 to March 10, 2020)

Late Testing Exam: Rs. **20,000** per AP Exam (For registration from Nov 16, 2019 to March 10, 2020)

Refund Policy:

No refund will be given once the payment has been made.

Please Note:

- *Registration will be on a first-come-first served basis as we have limited capacity at USIEF,*
- *Payment is due within 3 business days of submitting registration form, or by November 13, whichever comes first.*
- *Payment must be received to complete registration and reserve your seat.*
- *Online registration does not ensure a seat for the chosen AP Exam(s) until payment is received for the tests registered. To complete registration formalities, please make payment at EducationUSA@USIEF, New Delhi within 3 days of submitting registration form. ONLY tests for which the payment has been done will be ordered by USIEF.*
- *Once registration formalities are complete, students cannot change the subject(s) chosen for the AP Exam(s),*
- *No refund for cancellations or no-shows,*
- *Cheques and DDs should be in exact multiples of the AP Exam fee (For example, for AP exams ordered for Regular Testing Cycle before November 13, 2019 the amount will be 'INR 13,500 X total number of tests').*

Registration Process

STEP 1: SIGN IN TO MY AP

Sign in to myap.collegeboard.org using your College Board student account login. This is the same login you use to access your AP scores, PSAT/NMSQT® scores, or register for the SAT®. If you don't have a student account, please sign up at collegeboard.org/register

STEP 2: JOIN AN EXAM

STEP 3: SUBMIT YOUR JOIN CODE

Check the India AP Exam schedule on ap-india@collegeboard.org. Enter the unique join code for each regular or late testing exam you wish to take at this test center and click Submit. (Repeat for each exam you wish to take.)

STEP 4: VERIFY EXAM INFORMATION

Confirm the exam name, exam date, and test center name are what you want.

Click the Join a Course or Exam button.

STEP 5: FILL OUT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The first time you register in My AP, you'll need to fill out some registration information. Provide accurate information – this will be on your personalized AP labels for exam day. You only have to do this once. Repeat STEPS 2-4 for each exam you wish to take.

STEP 6: PAY TEST CENTER WITHIN 3 BUSINESS DAYS OF COMPLETING ONLINE REGISTRATION OR BY THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE, WHICHEVER COMES FIRST. EMAIL YOUR PAYMENT DETAILS TO THE TEST CENTER COORDINATOR SO THAT THE TEST CENTER MAY MATCH YOUR PAYMENT TO YOUR ONLINE REGISTRATION.

- Acknowledge that I will need to pay the test center and register online with the College Board by the stated deadline to complete my AP Exam registration and receive an Admission Ticket from the test center, or I will not be able to test.
- Acknowledge that I have read and agree to test center policies above, with respect to payment deadline, payment instructions, refunds and cancellations.
- Acknowledge that I will bring my Admission Ticket along with an original, VALID PASSPORT or AADHAR CARD to the test center on exam day, or I will not be able to test.
- Photocopies of the ID will not be accepted.
- Plan visa applications or ID renewals in advance, to ensure you have valid ID in hand on test day.

STEP 7: RECEIVE ADMISSION TICKET FROM TEST CENTER

The test center will provide an admission ticket to you after they have ordered your exams. Ticket will be provided no later than April 15, 2020. This ticket is confirmation your seat has been reserved. You will need this ticket on exam day, along with an original, valid passport or Aadhar Card, or you will not be able to test.
