

## Missed the AP deadline! Register for Late AP Exams

- Subject to good scores and university rules, students can earn course credits at colleges in the U.S. and 60 other countries\*
- Gain advanced knowledge about a field before formal study at a university
- Advanced Placement (AP) Exams train students in taking higher level tests in a university setting
- Helps students improve scores in other standardized tests
- Helps students decide what subjects to pursue in college
- Students who score a 3 or higher on an AP Exam typically earn higher GPAs in college than their non-AP student peers

Pay via Cheque/DD/Online Transfer (INR 13,500 per Late AP exam) within 3 days of registering online
