Registration Dates: February 12 to March 19, 2019

Test fee: INR 12,500 per AP exam

Payment is due within 3 business days of submitting registration form, or by **March 21**, whichever comes first. Payment **must be** received to complete registration and reserve your seat. After **March 14, 2019** only Demand Drafts will be accepted as payment for the AP Exams.

Registration Process

STEP 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To choose EducationUSA@USIEF, New Delhi as your test center • Click on the link: https://del57sxh.apregindia.com/ (Please select your AP Exam(s) carefully; once registered no changes or refunds will be permitted)
STEP 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Print a copy of the complete confirmation email sent to you after registration
STEP 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit EducationUSA@USIEF, New Delhi Center with a print of the complete confirmation email • Pay via Cheque/DD (INR 12,500 per AP exam) within 3 days of submitting registration form • Cheques and Demand Drafts are to be issued in the name of USIEF-EAS Account (payable at New Delhi)
STEP 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will receive a confirmation on DDs/Cheque(s) cleared by EducationUSA@USIEF, New Delhi
STEP 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • By May 1, 2019 you will receive your admission ticket (admit card) via email (Please ensure to check your spam folder in case you do not see the email in your inbox)

- *Registration will be on a first-come-first served basis as we have limited capacity at USIEF,*
- *Online registration does not ensure a seat for the chosen AP Exam(s) until payment is received for the tests registered. To complete registration formalities, please make payment at EducationUSA@USIEF, New Delhi within 3 days of submitting registration form,*
- *Once registration formalities are complete, students cannot change the subject(s) chosen for the AP Exam(s),*
- *No refund for cancellations or no-shows,*
- *Cheques and DDs should be in exact multiples of the AP Exam fee (i.e., INR 12,500 X total number of tests).*
