Speaking about the event, Adam Grotzky, Executive Director, USIEF, said “Indian students who are studying or have studied at American colleges and universities are citizen ambassadors who can provide accurate, *often* deeply personal, and nuanced narratives of their academic, extra-curricular and cross-cultural experiences in the United States. Such occasions to interact with several students and alumni of different U.S. universities, all in one place, help prospective students in India to gain a closer look at the opportunities, challenges, and returns that such educational experiences have provided to many like them. I encourage prospective students (and their families) to take advantage of this event to make informed decisions about the higher education experiences they want to create for themselves at their chosen U.S. universities.”
